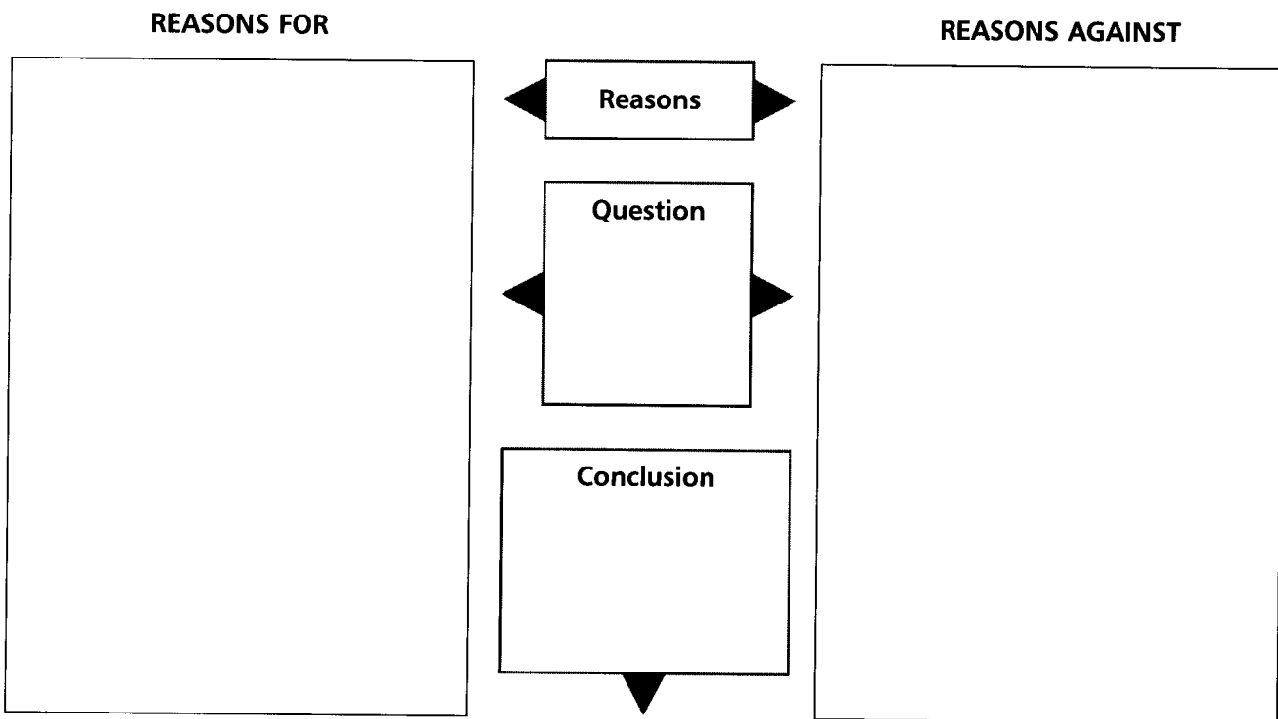


Discussion Web

1. Think about the position statement and fill in the graphic organizer.

3. Meet with your partner and compare/contrast the evidence you gave for each side of the statement.
4. Reach consensus on whether you agree or disagree with the statement and choose ONE reason that best supports your decision.
5. Next, join another pair and reach consensus. Again, choose ONE reason that best supports your decision.
6. Report your decision to the class.
